BEST PRACTICE

The Indianapolis chapter of Indiana Black Expo, Inc. partnered with Warren Central High School to provide ScholarTrack labs and support to scholars. IBE volunteers went to Warren Central High School during the school day in order to assist as many Scholars as possible.

HOW TO...

Step 1: Create a partnership between a community organization and a high school.

Step 2: Train volunteers on ScholarTrack and the Scholar success Program.

Step 3: Set up a time during the school day when volunteers can visit the high school. Ensure access to computer labs or technology.

Step 4: Meet with all Scholars (split them up into groups small enough to fit into a computer lab) to ensure they have ScholarTrack accounts and know how to complete the Scholar Success Program.

Step 5: Visit the school on enough occasions to ensure all Scholars are on track to complete the Scholar Success Program.
